

PVV Dog Park

Overview

- A. The PVV Large Dog Park is intended for dogs that are in good health, immunized, and are friendly and well-socialized with other dogs.
- B. To Gain access to the park you must submit an application to the Committee which must include copies of your pets immunization records and we may ask for a copy of your identification as well, in addition to proof that you are a PROPERTY OWNER within the Pleasant View Village residential area. We may take a photo of your pet for our records.
- C. You must read, understand and agree to the Rules and Guidelines for use of the park.
- D. You must participate in a short orientation event to help you better understand safe and harmonious use of the park.
- E. Individuals that **own** property within the residential portion of Pleasant View Village may have access to the Dog Park provided they follow the rules and guidelines and pay any fees/deposits associated with use of the Park.
- F. Except under certain limited conditions, the Park is not open to individuals and their pets that do not own property and reside in the Residential portion of Pleasant View Village.
 - 1. The committee may, at their own discretion, allow access to non-residents/non-owners whom may be helpful with park design and/or maintenance or choose to help with special events.
 - 2. The committee may, at their own discretion, designate certain days of the month or year, wherein non-residents/non-members may bring their pets in during special events.

- G. The Park is open from Sunrise to Sunset most days. It may be closed without notice for maintenance, repairs, or special events.
- H. If the gates are locked, the park is closed, regardless of the time of day. Do Not Enter.
- I. The park may or may not be electronically monitored at any given time at the discretion of The PVV Board or the Dog Park Committee.
- J. Use of the Dog Park is a privilege, not a right. This privilege may be suspended or revoked at any time at the sole discretion of the Dog Park Committee.
- K. Your HOA dues must be current to use the park and you must be in good standing, with no outstanding violations on your property and no pending legal or administrative actions.

Rules:

- No unattended dogs or children allowed at any time.
- Carry your leash with you at all times.
- No Humans without dogs, no dogs without humans.
- No soliciting of any sort.
- No small children, nor toddlers, nor infants, nor strollers.
- Dogs should run, people should NOT run.
- No Firearms of any sort, concealed or otherwise, in the park at any time. The park is Private Property and you may NOT bring your weapon into the park regardless of whether you possess a license to carry a concealed weapon.
- No grooming of pets within the park.
- No puppies under 6 months.
- No dogs that are in heat. No pregnant dogs.
- No persons under 16 years of age without an adult.
- Do not bring more dogs than you are capable of controlling.
- No FOOD OF ANY KIND, this includes no human food and **no dog treats.**
- No alcoholic beverages of any kind, in any kind of container.

- Do not enter the park if you are intoxicated or impaired in any way.
- No tobacco use including all smoking and “smokeless tobacco.”
- No Glass containers.
- No Vaping.
- No rope toys.
- Do not allow your dogs to dig holes. If your dog digs a hole, refill it promptly.
- Do not climb or sit on equipment/fixtures that are intended for dogs.
- Do not allow dogs to sit on equipment/fixtures that are intended for humans.
- Stay clear of the gate (entry/exit area) once inside the park so that others may transition smoothly.
- Dog waste must be cleaned up and disposed of immediately.
- Enter through the gate only; you may **not** climb over the fence nor drop a dog over the fence.
- All pets must wear the green colored collar and/or ID Tag provided to the owner when inside the park. No Exceptions.
- No dog whistles or loud toys.
- All owners must wear the lanyard provided to them when inside the park. No Exceptions.
- You may **not** loan out your lanyard nor your collar. **No Exceptions.**
- Dogs that are aggressive must be removed from the park immediately.
- Barking/howling/growling must be discouraged. If it continues for more than one minute, your dog must be removed from the park.
- Dogs suffering from any contagious illness must never enter the park.
- Injured dogs must be removed from the park immediately.
- You must close the gates behind you when entering or exiting.
- Do not enter the Transition Area when it is occupied in any way.
- Users use the Park **AT THEIR OWN RISK.**
- You are responsible for any injuries or damage caused by you and/or your pet.
- No music. No yelling. No spitting. No guests. No parties.
- No spiked collars. No pinch collars. No pronged collars.
- No vehicles of any sort other than wheelchairs.

- No aerial drones without written permission from the Dog Park Committee or Property Owner.

General Guidelines

- Please do not drive to the dog park. We do not provide parking. If you are using the park, it is assumed you reside in Pleasant View Village and will be walking TO AND FROM THE PARK.
- Remove the dog's leash when you have entered the park's off-leash area.
- Bring your own water and bowl. Discourage sharing.
- Watch your dog the ENTIRE time. Do not get distracted and do not let your dog out of sight. Please consider leaving your phone OFF or in your pocket. It is important that you *watch your DOG not your PHONE*.
- Help your dog to socialize. Stay close to him/her until the dog is comfortable.
- Please consider introducing yourself and your pet to other members of the dog park, as you will likely see them often. Do not, however, get so distracted socializing that you lose track of your pet.
- Leave dog toys at home. They are frequently lost and they can start fights.
- Do not get into conflicts with other pet owners.
- Do not tell other owners they cannot enter the park because you are using it or because your dog is not friendly. If your dog is not friendly, it should NEVER be in the park under any conditions.
- Explore the park for any conditions that you think may be hazardous to your dog.
- Please do not use the park for professional dog training.
- If you encounter a person and/or dog that does not belong in the park, please do not be confrontational.
- If a fight occurs between two or more dogs, please leave the park immediately and exchange contact information outside the park.
